

Welcome to Philadelphia for the 33rd annual Craft Brewers Conference (CBC) & BrewExpo America®, presented by the Brewers Association. We're excited to have you at the industry's largest gathering of small and independent craft brewers.

CBC was last in Philadelphia in 2005, with 1,350 attendees and 113 exhibiting companies. Back again over a decade later, CBC is projected to have 12,000 attendees and 835 exhibiting companies this year.
