WHAT: Philadelphia, Pennsylvania—a city with a rich history known for independence will welcome the 33rd edition of the <u>Craft Brewers Conference</u> & <u>BrewExpo</u> <u>America®</u> (CBC) from May 3-6. the annual State of the Industry address, as well as **keynote speaker Billy Beane**, Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations for the Oakland A's and the inspirational subject of bestselling book and subsequent movie *Moneyball*.*

Beane is considered one of the most progressive and talented baseball executives in the game. He will share his innovative, winning approach to management and leadership, and how his *Moneyball* philosophy can be adopted for the craft brewing industry.

WHY: As demand for craft beer from small and independent brewers increases, CBC brings the community together in a collaborative and educational environment. New and veteran brewers have an opportunity to connect, share ideas and learn about a wide range of topics including brewery operations, brewpubs, export development, government affairs, packaging breweries, quality, safety, selling craft beer, start-ups, sustainability and technical brewing.
